Dear Stakeholder:

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) has scheduled a set of two public meetings to obtain input on realigning SR-79 to be more efficient, less congested, and safer.

Under consideration are a variety of approaches to realign SR-79 between Domenigoni Parkway in the south and Gilman Springs Road in the north.

This project was first identified in preliminary studies that began in 1998. The results of those studies and more recent and have recently been embodied in a Purpose and Need document that is the beginning of the formal environmental approval process.

The attached newsletter gives you more information on the project, including a map of the study area and locations where the new roadway may be located. The intent is for any new alignment to be able to serve both vehicles and transit.

Public meetings are being held as a way to obtain your input on issues and concerns you may have with the project. We are hoping, through these meetings, to better identify the most feasible approaches to address these traffic problems.

The workshops will be held from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Displays and other information will be available showing the project location and experts will be on hand to answer your questions. There also will be a 20 minute presentation on the project and 45 minutes of discussion groups.

A list of meeting locations and dates is provided in the newsletter. This is an important opportunity for you to provide input to the transportation future of Riverside County. We hope you will be able to attend.
